This was in front of the rock

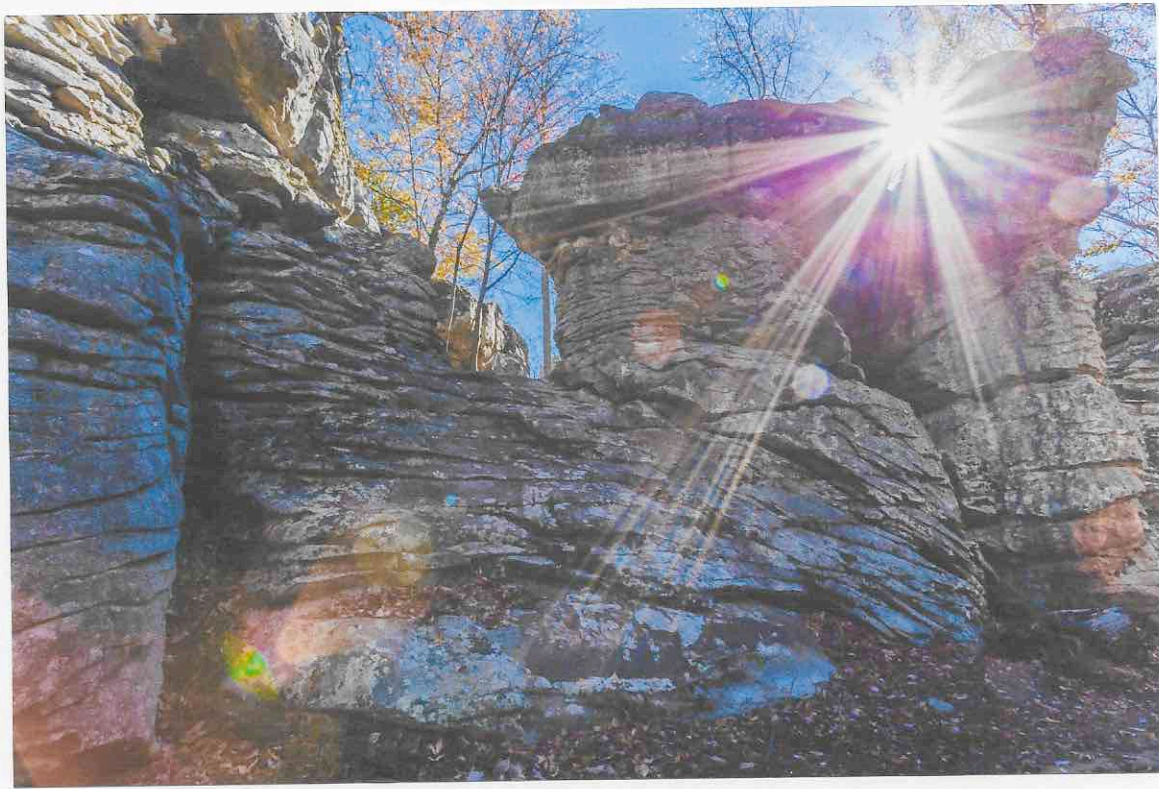
so we don't know what it

to "Shaws Bar-B-Q."

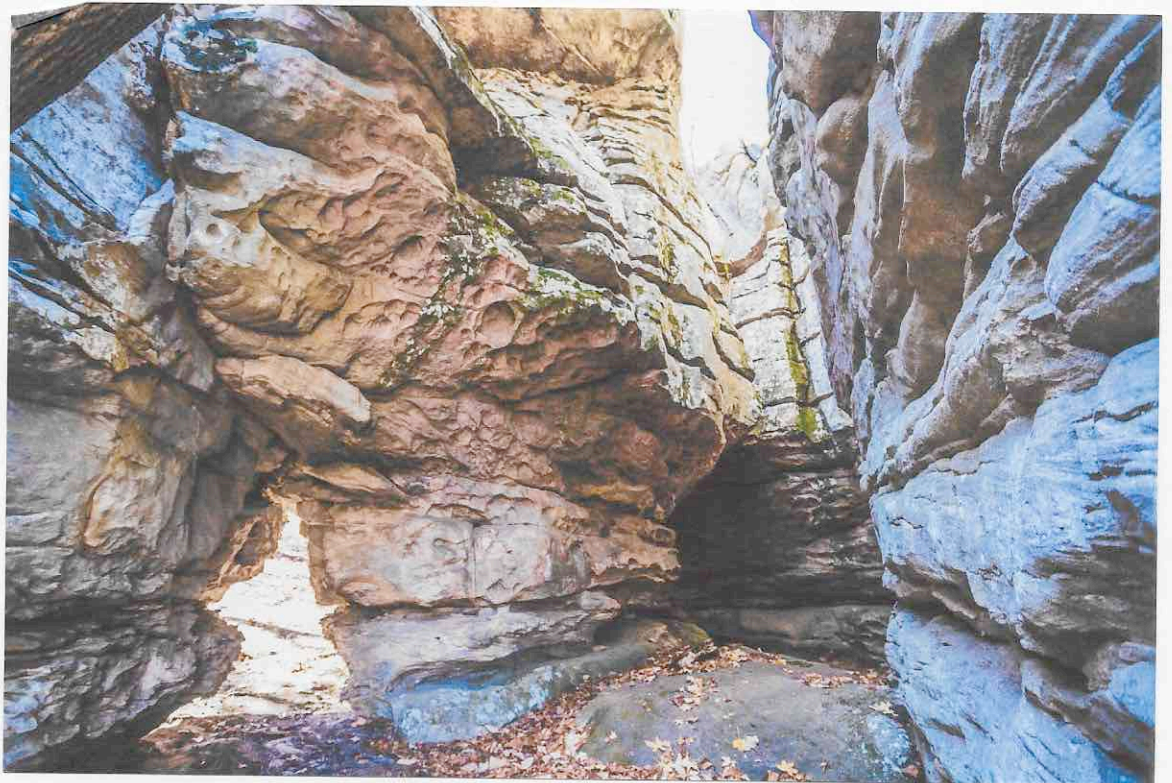
